Summer School Information

Summer School Registration will begin in the Marshfield High School Library on Monday June 27th from 8:00am to Noon.

Registration will continue on Tuesday June 28, Wednesday June 29, Thursday June 30, and Friday July 1.

Summer School classes will begin on Tuesday July 5th on the third floor at Marshfield High School. Room assignments will be announced as students arrive. Students should enter by the gym door.

Summer School classes will meet for 24 days.

The first week will be abbreviated for the Fourth of July holiday.

Classes will meet Tuesday through Friday in the first week and will meet Monday through Friday for the next four weeks.

Classes will conclude on Friday August 5 with an abbreviated day.

Classes will meet in two different blocks. The first will run from 8:00 to 9:45. The second will run from 10:00 to 11:45.

With so few class meetings, students will be allowed only two excused absences.

Students who exceed two absences will not receive credit for the class.

Students can only take two classes in a Summer session.

Which classes run in which block will be determined by enrollment.

The tuition **per course** for Marshfield residents is \$200.00. Out of District students pay \$250.00 per course. No credit will be awarded without a full tuition payment.

Checks can be made payable to the Town of Marshfield.

Resources are limited during the Summer Session. Nurses and counseling staff are not available for students. Teachers will not have access to student records to guide individualized instruction.

The Summer Session is an opportunity for students to demonstrate that promotion to the next sequenced course is appropriate. Attendance and participation are the central factors in making that decision.

Planned course offerings include: Biology, English 1, 2, 3 & 4, Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, US History, World History. Hybrid sections are likely.
